



WHAT IS THE MARINE CORPS LEAGUE? The Marine Corps League is a fraternal order devoted to the ideals of the U.S.M.C. Our members are honorably discharged Marines; U.S.M.C. active duty or reserve Marines; retired Marines, and U.S. Navy Corpsmen who have served honorably with the F.M.F. - enlisted and officers. All MCL officers are elected from the membership, regardless of USMC rank or duty status.

MISSION STATEMENT: Members of the Marine Corps League join together in camaraderie and fellowship for the purpose of preserving the traditions and promoting the interests of the United States Marine Corps. This is accomplished by banding together those who are now serving in the United States Marine Corps and those who have been honorably discharged from that service; voluntarily aiding and rendering assistance to all Marines and former Marines and to their widows and orphans, and by perpetuating the history of the United States Marine Corps through fitting acts to observe the anniversaries of historical occasions of particular interest to Marines. We act locally in assisting the U.S.M.C. in public activities, and notably, each year assisting the U.S.M.C Reserves in their Toys for Tots Campaign. We also work with the local NROTC, Eagle Scouts and JRNROTC programs, awarding special achievement awards. We support the USO and Community programs such as the Young Marines, composed of young people from 8 through 18. We support the Wounded Warriors Barracks and "Hope For The Warriors" programs at Camp Lejeune. *Initial membership costs \$35.00 per year, and \$30.00 thereafter. Membership fees are waived for Marines while "in Country". We have 50+ Detachments in North Carolina, with over 3500 members. No member is assigned or given duties except those that each is able, or wants, to do. We want you to join us and bring other Marines to the Marine Corps League, especially younger Marines, who often are unaware that the MCL exists or what it does. We meet the first Thursday of each month, except July, at the VFW in Cary at 522 Reedy Creek Road. See the application form, on our www.tarheelmcl.org website.
