The only required uniform item is our Red Cover with EGA, everything else is optional. You are in uniform when wearing the Red Cover with EGA. Patches to be worn on the cover identifying the Tar Heel Detachment can be purchased through the Semper Fi Store at the National website. You can purchase any uniform items you feel you may need. Meetings. Each meeting is conducted under the Marine Corps League Ritual manual. In the Marine Corps League, no military ranks are recognized. All MC Leaguers are equal.
